Kindergarten and Daycare in Cusco, Peru

Located in the city of Cusco, the kindergarten and daycare is a public educational institution. It is located in one of the main markets of Cusco. The majority of the children are from families that work in the market. This school takes care of the children while their parents are working. More than 30 children, ages 2 to 5 years old use this school. It has a poor infrastructure and lacks resources.

Volunteers can be teacher's assistants. As such, participants will spend time with the children, playing, singing, feeding them and taking care of them in general.



Participants will fly into Cusco. After being picked up at the airport, participants will have an orientation. The next day, there will be a walking tour of Cusco.

Then, participants will begin at the project. (It is recommended to arrive into Lima on Friday morning and then take a domestic flight to Cusco to arrive on Friday during the day.)

Volunteers live with Peruvian families specially selected for this program. These homestays give participants the opportunity to share day to day experiences with the host family.
